



## 2017 New Investigators Workshop

The 41st Annual Meeting of the American Society of Preventive Oncology will be held at the Grand Hyatt Hotel in Seattle, Washington, from March 11-14, 2017. The New Investigators Workshop, first held in 1993, is an opportunity for pre- and postdoctoral trainees to meet with nationally recognized leaders in the field of preventive oncology, and to present their research for discussion and constructive criticism. The research may be completed work, work in progress, or ideas in the planning stages.

The workshop will take place **Sunday, March 12, 2017, from 9:00AM – 12:00PM**. Faculty for the workshop will be announced at a later date.

Applications are invited from **pre- and post-doctoral trainees** at any recognized institution. Applicants must **not** have participated in this particular workshop in the past.

**There is no application form. To apply, please submit the following:**

1. A face sheet listing: a) Your (applicant's) name; your department, institution, mailing address, and email address; b) The name, title, and email address of your sponsor (the principal investigator or mentor with whom you are working, who need not be an ASPO member); c) The title of your research project
2. A 1-2 page description of your research project;
3. Your curriculum vitae
