Please see this opportunity to participate in the Community & Science Program, held in conjunction with the 44th Annual American Society of Preventative Oncology Conference in Tucson, Arizona March 22-24, 2020.

The Community & Science Program will bring together NCI-Designated Cancer Center professionals working on the Cancer Center Support Grant (CCSG) Community Outreach and Engagement (COE) component to support and enhance cancer prevention and control activities in their local community. The goal of this program is to encourage bidirectional communication between researchers and COE professionals.

At the Annual Meeting, Community & Science Program participants will have the opportunity to:

- Attend the ASPO Conference
- Attend designated sessions focused on COE
- Share best practices for engaging researchers in COE activities
- Participate in a Researcher ↔ COE "buddy" program with researchers from different Cancer Centers
- Attend the Early Career Investigators Lunch session and provide feedback on their research
- Receive up to \$1,000 in travel assistance for conference attendance

Applications are invited from cancer center staff working on COE activities within their cancer centers (e.g., Research Coordinator, Program Manager, Community Health Educator, Patient Navigator, etc.)

Please read instructions and complete the application (pages 2 –4), and submit a letter of recommendation from your center's COE director along with your application. Applications are due **Friday, January 31, 2020**.

- 3. Complete all fields on both pages on your computer, and then save the completed form.
