Transportation

Air:

The Roosevelt Hotel located in Midtown Manhattan, New York, directly opposite of Grand Central Station and is accessible via LaGuardia International Airport, John F. Kennedy International Airport and Newark Liberty International Airport.

LaGuardia Airport International Airport

LaGuardia Airport is approximately 10 miles (30-60 minutes depending on traffic travel) from the Roosevelt Hotel.

Taxis provide service from the airport to Grand Central Station, Midtown Manhattan, NY. Any taxi fare could cost \$30-\$70.

Shared Ride Services:

Shuttle to subway and rail: The Q70 SBS LaGuardia Link *Must pay fare using a MetroCard or exact change in coins at curbside machines before boarding. Out of terminal B, C, D to Manhattan (Midtown or South of 59th St.) Subway 7, E, F, M, R subway lines. A one-way trip on MTA buses or subways costs \$2.75. MetroCards can be purchased at MetroCard vending machines located throughout LaGuardia Airport terminals. Passengers using MetroCards get a free transfer from their bus to the subway. For LaGuardia Link Q70 SBS (Select Bus Service) and M60 SBS bus service. Please retain your paper ticket to ride. Travelers leaving or heading to Terminal A can take the Q47 bus, with connection to the 7, E, F, M, R subway lines at 74 St/Roosevelt Ave or the M60 SBS to Manhattan. Newark Liberty International Airport

The Newark Airport is approximately 16 miles (35-60 minutes depending on traffic travel) from the Roosevelt Hotel.

Taxis provide service from the airport to Grand Central Station, Midtown Manhattan, NY. Any taxi fare could cost \$47-\$90.

AirTrain Newark and MTA Subways: Midtown Manhattan, New York Penn Station W. 34 St. with a connection from Amtrack & NJ Transit at Newark Liberty Airport Station with an estimated cost of \$12.50 for about 30 minutes. For more information <http://www.panynj.gov/airports/ewr-to-from.html>

Bus: Newark Airport Express \$17 one way boarding in Terminal A, located on Level 1 outside a Bus Stop 5, stopping at Grand Central Station 41st Street between Park and Lexington avenues. For more information <https://www.newarkairportexpress.com/faq>.

John F. Kennedy International Airport

JFK Airport is approximately 15.6 miles (50-80 minutes depending on traffic travel) from the Roosevelt Hotel.

Taxis provide service from the airport to Grand Central Station, Midtown Manhattan, NY. Taxis at JFK Airport charge a flat fare of \$52 for trips between the airport and Manhattan. Taxis impose a \$4.50 surcharge during peak hours (4-8 p.m. weekdays, excluding holidays), for a fare of \$56.50.

AirTrain JFK and MTA Subways: Midtown Manhattan, New York Penn Station W. 34 St. with a connection from MTA NYC Transit E Subway at Jamaica Station with an estimated cost of \$7.75 for about 50 minutes. For more information <http://www.panynj.gov/airports/jfk-airtrain.html>

Bus with Subway and Commuter Rail: The Q70 SBS LaGuardia Link *Must pay before boarding using a machine at the bus stop. Out of terminal B, C, D to Manhattan (Midtown or South of 59th St.) Subway 7, E, F, M, R, 7 subway lines. A one-way trip on MTA buses or subways costs \$2.75. MetroCards can be purchased at MetroCard vending machines located throughout LaGuardia Airport terminals. Passengers using MetroCards get a free transfer from their bus to the subway. For LaGuardia Link Q70 SBS (Select Bus Service) and M60 SBS bus service, passengers must pay their fare using a MetroCard or **exact change** in coins at curbside machines before boarding. Please retain your paper ticket to ride. Travelers leaving or heading to Terminal A can take the Q47 bus, with connection to the 7, E, F, M, R subway lines at 74 St/Roosevelt Ave or the M60 SBS to Manhattan.
